S1821 – An Act combating climate change; S1869 – An Act to protect our environment and lower our carbon footprint; H1726 – An Act to promote green infrastructure, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and create jobs

Chairman, Distinguished Legislators,

I have been an engineer for over 30 years with my name on a patent, including having developed a prototype for performing surgery over the Internet. I am also on the state board of directors of two state organizations, as well as Chairman of my Ward.

To understand the real purpose of the Carbon Tax, you have to first understand the true definition of socialism. Frederic Bastiat wrote in 1850 that the law was created in a free society to protect your property; but, when the laws are rewritten in order to legally plunder the people, this is socialism; and, as I heard a person who lived most of his life in a communist country say, "The only difference between socialism and communism is that the socialist hasn't decided to kill you, yet."

How are socialists able to rewrite the laws? By clever sales techniques, by phony altruism, by threats real and imagined, by political intrigue and coercion, and by graft and corruption. The Carbon Tax is a liberty-stealing piece of legislation that replaces our rights with privileges. This bill is a complete evisceration of the right to privacy, as enforcement requires tracking our habits and electronically requesting "papers please" everywhere we drive. What is being silently implemented all around us is the Trojan Horse of global Technocracy from the 1934 Technocracy Study Guide written by M. King Hubbert. When technology is a tool, there is freedom; but, when technology rules us, there is tyranny (read "Technocracy Rising" by Patrick Wood at www.technocracyrising.com).

Sure, there is global climate change, but the sun has been the major driver of temperature, with CO₂ a lagging indicator by about 800 years. Climate scientists using their political models based on the opposite have been even less accurate than Hubbert's Peak, both having to continuously update their predictions as they are proven wrong time and time again, posting fake news in attempt to save face. The fact that shackling the entire planet with the measures of the Paris Climate Accord will only reduce global temperatures by just 0.05°C by 2100 not only proves that humans are really not the cause of global climate change, but verifies that there is a political objective at work. Americans rejected Technocracy in the 1940's, when they realized Nazi Germany was the very first Technocracy. That reason is just as valid today.

There is more of a threat to humanity from an EMP than from the gas we exhale, from a polar shift than from human caused global warming, and there is more of a threat to humanity from once eradicated infectious diseases that have been allowed to cross our borders for the political ends of erasing our borders.
